Role of Outreach Ambassadors

Seniors Outreach Ambassadors are a trained group on individuals who have the role of providing outreach to isolated seniors. The volunteers will act as ambassadors, providing connections and relevant information within their communities and among their peers.

They will befriend seniors inviting and offering to accompany them to a range of different programs while also linking them to any other services that may be of benefit.

Additionally, Outreach Ambassadors will refer at-risk and vulnerable seniors they meet in the community to the *Seniors Outreach Coordinator* who will work with the referred seniors to develop a plan of action to address their needs.
